The book <u>Call it Courage</u> takes place on HIKUERU, an island atoll in French Polynesia. Today you get to learn more about this small island by exploring its land, plants, animals, and author.

Please answer these questions in your composition book.

ACTIVITY 1:

Let's take a look at the atoll.

a. On Google Earth, type "Atoll Hikueru, French Polynesia". Explore the atoll. From looking at the island, what are your impressions of the atoll?

b. Looking on Wikipedia, list three facts about the atoll that you learned.

2. According to websites about GEMSTONES, what rare gemstone is found on Hikueru? What creature does is come from? What impact does it have on the economy?

3. Visit two tourism sites to look at pictures of different French Polynesian islands. Compare two different TOURS that you could take. Include where, when, cost, activities, food, etc.

4. According to the IRD website, what happened to Hikueru in 1903? Do people live there today? Why or why not?
