If you have more chapters than activities you may use some more than once. (If some chapters are short; you may combine some. – Just make sure you do all 10 activities.)
3. Write each chapter number next to the activity below and on the page.
4. Make a front and back cover for your book on this paper. (Include a picture & the title on the front and a summary on back.)

Chapter Activities:

- ___ Write a good paragraph summarizing what happened.
- ___ Copy a quote from a character and tell why it is important.
- ___ Describe a part that surprised you and why it did.
- ___ Give an example of foreshadowing and explain it.
- ___ Give an example of a simile, metaphor, and personification used and explain it. (You can pull from multiple chapters if needed.)
- ___ Explain a situation or choice made and tell how you would handle it differently. – Explain.
- ___ Use a Thinking Map to explain something from the chapter.
- ___ Create a character web/bubble map for a main character.
- ___ Vocabulary – Find a chapter with at least 3 “Juicy Words” in it & create a graphic organizer/Thinking Map explaining them.
- ___ *Other (Your choice) – Be creative and do what you want to explain or represent this chapter.
